

The Director of 2020 Consultancy have been commissioned by the Lancaster Canal Regeneration Partnership to carry out a feasibility study into the potential for a multi-user trail along the Lancaster Canal from Kendal to Lancaster. This is a study that is focusing on how achievable the proposal is and the main constraints that would need to be resolved. The study provides no commitment to delivering a scheme.

As part of the study, they wish to engage with a range of stakeholders including yourself, to gain an understanding of your views on this proposal along with any specific matters you would like to see taken into consideration during the development of proposals that may arise through the completion of the feasibility study. To allow their project team to understand your views and comments, they have setup a questionnaire that contains 13 questions related to the Lancaster Canal and provides the opportunity for any comments to be recorded.

In usual circumstances, the consultation process would allow stakeholders the opportunity to meet with our project team to discuss specific items, concerns, or aspirations in greater detail. Their intention is to collate requests initially before trying to arrange a date that is suitable for as many as possible. This consultation will last three weeks and will commence on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May, running until the 14<sup>th</sup> June 2021 for the wider stakeholders such as residents and visitors who are interested in the Canal. As you have been identified as a stakeholder with a potential interest in the Canal, you can complete the questionnaire anytime from now until the 14<sup>th</sup> June.
