(YEALAND ROAD, YEALAND CONYERS, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Yealand Road, Yeland Conyers for a distance of 50 meters either side of property known as New Barn.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 3rd July 2018 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 10th July 2018 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Alternative route will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency sewer repair works to be carried out.
