(A683 BAY GATEWAY, HEATON WITH OXCLIFFE, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Bay Gateway, Heaton with Oxcliffe from its junction with Northgate, to its junction with B5273 Mellishaw Lane.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 1930 hours on Wednesday 23rd January 2019 until 0630 hours on Thursday 24th January 2019 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Northgate – B5273 Ovangle Road – B5273 Mellishaw Lane.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
